Page number:	Do not number the pages
Headers / footers:	Do not insert headers/footers
Colour:	Text in black Figures, graphs and tables can be in colour
Title:	24 pt bold, first letter in each word in capitals. Max. 100 letters incl. spaces Centered One blank line after title
Author(s) name(s) & Affiliation:	12 pt bold type and center First name in full, family name followed by a comma. On the same line type the organisation the author is affiliated with abbreviate organisation name if possible.

Paragraphs: Leave one line between paragraphs

Do not insert extra spacing in paragraph and line spacing

Do not indent at all

Do not use numbers to identify headings

Headings to be used: The following headings must be used in the following order:

Contact

Executive Summary

Introduction Conclusion

Acknowledgements

References

Other headings will depend upon your specific paper

Headings format: 12 pt bold capitals

Do not indent or center Insert a blank line below Second level headings

12 pt bold, with the first letter in each word in capitals, the rest in

lower case

Do not indent or centre

Do not insert a blank line below

Table, figure, graph and photograph headings 10 pt bold type

Table heading above the table

Figure, graph and picture heading below

Clearly Label, ex: "Table 1 of Figure" (no full stop afterwards)

Executive summary: The executive summary

The executive summary contained in your manuscript will be copied and published in the executive summaries book. Length must not be longer than 400 words. Words only (no figures, tables, graphs) include the background of the work and its aims, the methods/techniques used (briefly), the main results obtained

and the conclusions drawn

Contact details: In the executive summaries book details of a contact person for

each manuscript will be published. At the beginning of your

manuscript please type the following information:

Equations & formulae: Align on the left margin

Scientific symbols: Type all scientific symbols in bold

Super & sub scripts: 8 pt bold type

In the production of the CD-ROM symbols often scramble. Only

symbols in bold can be proofed.

Citations in the text should be denoted with the author's surname Referencing:

> and the year of publication (e.g.: using the data obtained by Parkpain et al. (2000) or using data from literature (Grigg 1996,

Pokrajac & Jones 2000).

Provide a reference section at the end of your manuscript, including an alphabetical list of the authors and the year of

publication referred to in the text.

Remember to write the working title in italic.

Use the examples written below.

If two or more citations for the same author are made for a single

year, identify sequentially in lower case letters, e.g. (1995a).

Bitmap format) in the body of the manuscript. Do not use shading

Spell check: Be sure to spell check your manuscript
